Trabalhou com vários coreógrafos como Veredon Gray, Laura Alonso, Giorgio Madia, Ivan Cavallari, Jochen Heckmann, Hans-Henning Paar, Marco Goecke, Stephan Thoss, Rui Horta, Robert North e Christian Spuck.

Desde o semestre de inverno de 2011/12, Krzysztof Zawadzki é professor de dança clássica na Ballet Academy of the University of Music and Performing Arts Munich (Hochschule für Musik und Theater München), escola que irá representar no CIB.
